Introductory/Ice Breaker Question

In this passage, Paul recounts a visit to Jerusalem with Barnabas and Titus. He explains that he went in response to a revelation from God; to present the Gospel he preached among the Gentiles to the church leaders. The passage highlights unity in the Gospel, freedom from legalism, and the recognition of Paul's ministry to the Gentiles.
